Objective	1) The programme seeks to open new schools in those habitations which do not have schooling facilities and strengthen existing school infrastructure through provision of additional class rooms, toilets, drinking water, maintenance grant and school improvement grants, 2) Existing schools with inadequate teacher strength are provided with additional teachers, while the capacity of existing teachers is being strengthened by extensive training, grants for developing teaching-learning materials and strengthening of the academic support structure at a cluster, block and district level, 3) SSA seeks to provide quality elementary education including life skills. SSA has a special focus on girl's education and children with special needs. SSA also seeks to provide computer education to bridge the digital divide.
Purpose	The **purpose** of Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) is to provide quality education to all children from pre-school to senior secondary levels, ensuring inclusivity, equity, and improving the overall education system in India.
