

# Pre-Matric Scholarship for Students of Minority Communities

## Schemes Details

<b>Department</b>	Education Department
<b>Objective</b>	To provide financial assistance to minority students and promote school education among economically weaker sections.
<b>Purpose</b>	The purpose of the Pre-Matric Scholarship for students of Minority Communities is to support and encourage the education of financially disadvantaged minority students at the school level.
<b>Benefits</b>	The scheme provides following benefits to students of religious minorities: 1) Sstd 1 to 5: Yearly Stipend of INR 1000 for day scholar, 2) For Std 6 to 10: INR 6,000 per year for hostel student and INR 1000 for day scholar
<b>Eligibility</b>	1) the student must be from religious minorities (i.e. Musim, Christian, Parsis, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain), 2) Student must be studying in Std 1 to 10 and should have scored atleast 50% in previous annual examination, 3) The annual household income of the applicant should not be more than INR 1 lakh
<b>Documents Required</b>	Photograph of the Student,Domicile Certificate,Minority Community Certificate,Previous Academic Record,Income Certificate,Aadhaar Card,Bank Account Details,Fee Receipt,Institution Verification Form.
