Schemes Details

Department	Energy & Petrochemicals Department
Objective	To promote rooftop solar adoption by providing financial support so households can generate their own clean electricity and reduce power bills.
Purpose	To ensure affordable or free electricity (up to 300 units), reduce dependence on conventional energy, cut carbon emissions, and enhance energy self-reliance for households.
Benefits	The central government provides financial support (subsidy) to make solar installation affordable. India Brand Equity Foundation, 1) ₹30,000 per kW up to 2 kW 2) ₹18,000 per kW for additional capacity up to 3 kW 3) Maximum subsidy up to ~₹78,000 (for systems ₹3 kW) Note - Some states may provide additional subsidy (Up to 30%) on top of the central subsidy.
Eligibility	The household must be an Indian citizen. The household must own a house with a roof that is suitable for installing solar panels. The household must have a valid electricity connection. The household must not have availed any other subsidy for solar panels.
Documents Required	Proof of identity. Proof of address. Electricity bill. Roof ownership certificate.
